The label 'Große Gewächs' is reserved for the best wines according to the VDP classification scheme. With its lightyellow colour, this Riesling brings together a particularly wide range of scents and smells. A light tone of petrol, typical for mature Rieslings, the scent of honey, herbs such as woodruff, mature apricots and candied lemon. The same density characterises the strong fragrances on the palate. This dry wine is intense, with a long finish and of a balanced harmony. A perfect match for dinner but also compelling to enjoy on its own.
