TASTING NOTE

Golden yellow in the glass. Very delicate, delicate aromas of yellow fruits mix with fresh citrus fruit. Quite full on the palate, a lush fruit that shows itself and also penetrates. Then this lively, classy acidity shoots up, from which the palate has to recover briefly. Because now the finish shows this wonderful, light saltiness and the tartness of a grated lime peel. Extremely exciting mouthfeel alternating between fruit, freshness and complexity. Goes well with crustaceans and anything that comes out of the sea.
