#### DESCRIPTION

The name of the "Bürgergarten" is a reinterpretation of the old term "Bergergarten", which refers to a garden situated on a hill. The very deep soil, which has been used for wine production for centuries, is composed of weathered yellow sandstone interspersed with layers of loess and clay. The special "Haardt sandstone" is still being produced today in the nearby quarry.
